

Artists make art. Art can be pictures or sculptures. Can you draw pictures? Maybe you're an artist, too.










What can you see in art? Where can you see art?

Some artists look in a mirror and paint their face.






Can you stand by a lion? No, you can't! Lions are beautiful, but they can eat you. Can you stand by a picture of a lion? Yes, you can.

Animals in art are great. You can stand by a picture of an animal and really look at the animal.






In this picture, there are six birds.

Lines and Shapes




Look at this picture of boats on a river. The artist draws dark lines for the boats, and light lines for the shadows on the water.

Artists draw lines with a pencil or a pen. They draw colored lines with a crayon.

Artists make shapes with lines and colors. There are lots of shapes in art. Look at this picture of a bedroom. Can you find these shapes?








Some artists use brushes and paints. They put the paints on a palette.


Artists mix paints. They make new colors. Red and blue make purple. Blue and yellow make green. Red and yellow make orange.



Many artists like the color blue. Blue is the color of the sky. It's the color of the ocean, too. Look at all the blue colors in this picture.



Ultramarine is the name of a beautiful blue color. It comes from stones in Asia.








Some artists use hammers and chisels. They make sculptures from stone.

These artists are in Cambodia. What color are the sculptures?





You can see stone sculptures in parks. Stone is a good material for sculptures. It's good in hot weather and in cold, rainy weather.

Artists make sculptures from wood, too. This artist makes sculptures of goats. His sculptures are small, but they are great. Look at his chisels. There are lots of them.






Materials

Some artists make pictures with fabric. This fabric picture is from Peru. It's a picture of a soccer game. There are 12 players. There are some fans, too. How many fans are there?






Some artists make sculptures with amazing materials. Look at these sculptures of people. What's the material in these sculptures? It's cans!






Museums
